A quorum was present, and the meeting was called to order at 12:04 p.m. by Chair Gage.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE PERSONNEL, PENSION AND INVESTMENT COMMITTEE MEETING OF OCTOBER 25, 2022

Approve the minutes of the Personnel, Pension and Investment Committee meeting of the October 25, 2022 meeting. This information was included in the Committee packet.

CONSIDER RECOMMENDATION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR APPROVAL OF MULTIPLE SVMC PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR RADIOLOGISTS TO PROVIDE INTERVENTIONAL, DIAGNOSTIC, AND MAMMOGRAPHY RADIOLOGY SERVICES TO SVMHS.

Gary Ray, Chief Administrative Officer, SVMC, reported SVMHS is presently operating under a group Professional Services Agreement with Salinas Valley Radiologists, Inc. (SVR) to provide diagnostic, interventional, and mammography radiology services at Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital (SVMH) and at Salinas Valley Medical Clinics (SVMC). The agreement will expire on December 16, 2022, at 12:00 am. After ongoing negotiations with the group, a number of the SVR physicians expressed interest in contracting individually with SVMHS to provide radiology services through SVMC. Drs. Basse, Bottari, and Zhang will provide interventional and diagnostic radiology services, Dr. Stemerman will provide mammography and diagnostic radiology services, and Dr. Wulff will provide mammography services under individual Professional Services Agreements through SVMC. The background/situation/rationale and financial implications were included in the packet

SVMC is in the process of recruiting additional diagnostic radiologists and has entered into a teleradiology agreement to provide after-hours teleradiology coverage as well as availability for daytime teleradiology services. SVMC management believes the combination of SVMC radiologists and teleradiology support will continue the high quality radiology services for SVMHS.

No public input received.

MOTION:

Upon motion by Committee member Lopez and second by Committee member Childs, the Personnel, Pension and Investment Committee recommends the Board of Directors approve the Contract Terms and Conditions of the Radiology Professional Services Agreements for Michael Basse, MD, Zachary Zhang, MD, Brenden Bottari, MD, Amy Lantis Stemerman, MD, and Kristen Wulff, MD.

FINANCIAL AND STATISTICAL REVIEW

Augustine Lopez, Chief Financial Officer, provided a financial and statistical performance review for the month ending October 2022. This information was included in the Committee packet.

Key highlights of the financial summary for October 2022 were: (1) Income from operations was \$0.7M with an operating margin of 1.1%, (2) Net income was -\$0.8M with a net income margin of - 1.4%; (3) Inpatient gross revenues 9%, favorable to the budget but total net patient revenues were \$2.2M/4% above budget; (4) Emergency Department gross revenues were 9% favorable to the budget; (5) Outpatient gross revenues were 10% favorable to the budget in Infusion Therapy, Radiology, Surgery and Cardiology; (6) Payor mix was unfavorable to the budget; (7) Total

normalized net patient revenues were \$51.0M, which was favorable to the budget by \$1.6M or 4.8%; (8) Inpatient surgeries were above budget and higher than expected outpatient business; (9) Average daily census was 132, 15% above budget and total admissions were above budget by 20%; (10) Total acute average length of stay (ALOS) Medicare traditional ALOS CMI adjusted was 9% unfavorable at 2.57 days with a Case Mix Index if 1.7; (11) Operating revenues were above expenses; (13) Days cash on hand was 333; days of net accounts receivable is 49.

Outpatient Surgeries were 6% (14 cases) above budget at 256; COVID cases decreased to 13 cases, a decrease of 73% over prior month; Out Patient Observation cases were below budget by 37% at 101.

PUBLIC INPUT

Mr. Victor Rey thanked Committee member and Board member Richard Turner for his service and stated that it was a privileged to serve with him. Thanked him for his commitment and dedication to the Finance Committee and the Board.

Committee member Turner stated there will be some challenging times ahead.

Chair Gage thanked Committee member Turner for his hard work.

Mr. Lopez thanked Chair Gage for her service.

Executive Summary

Salinas Valley Memorial Healthcare System (SVMHS) is presently operating under a group Professional Services Agreement with Salinas Valley Radiologists, Inc. (SVR) to provide diagnostic, interventional, and mammography radiology services at Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital (SVMH) and at Salinas Valley Medical Clinic (SVMC). The agreement will expire on December 16, 2022, at 12:00 am. Five of the SVR radiologists have contracted with SVMHS to provide radiology services under individual Professional Services Agreements (PSAs) through SVMC. SVMC has recruited additional diagnostic radiologists to provide necessary coverage at SVMH and SVMC.

Contract Terms and Conditions

The essential terms and conditions for the Agreements for Dr. Kamin and Dr. Browning are as follows:

1. PSA Terms and Conditions

- W-2 Reporting. Each Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with the radiologists provides W-2 relationship for IRS reporting requirements.
- <u>Compensation.</u> Base compensation is five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$550,000) per year in addition to fair market value productivity income based on Medical Group Management Association (MGMA) Median for Western Region wRVU compensation for additional diagnostic radiology services.
- Access to SVMHS Health Plan. Physician premium is projected based on fifteen percent (15%) of SVMHS cost for coverage.
- Access to SVMHS 403(b) and 457 Retirement Plans. SVMHS will make a five percent (5%) base contribution to the 403b plan that vests after three years. Based on federal contribution limits this contribution is capped at sixteen thousand five hundred (\$16,500) annually.
- Continuing Medical Education (CME). One (1) week off for Continuing Medical Education (CME) and a two thousand four hundred dollar (\$2,400) annual stipend for CME.
- Professional Liability Insurance. The Radiologists will receive an occurrence based professional liability policy through BETA Healthcare Group.

2. Recruitment Agreements

> Recruitment incentives which will be structured as a forgivable loans over two years of service.

Meeting our Mission, Vision, Goals

Strategic Plan Alignment:

The addition of Dr. Kamin and Dr. Browning to the SVMC radiology program is aligned with SVMHS' strategic priorities for service and growth pillars. SVMHS continues to develop its infrastructure that engages our physicians in a meaningful way, promotes efficiencies in care delivery and creates opportunities for expansion of services. This investment provides a platform for growth that can be developed to better meet the needs of our hospital and clinic patients.

Financial/Quality/Safety/Regulatory Implications

The compensation proposed in these radiology agreements have been reviewed by independent valuation and compensation consulting firms to confirm that the terms contemplated are fair market value and commercially reasonable.

Recommendations

Administration recommends that the Board make the following findings:

- The recruitment of Radiologists to Salinas Valley Medical Clinic is in the best interest of the public health of the communities served by the District, and
- The recruitment benefits and incentives the hospital proposes for these recruitments are necessary in order to relocate and attract appropriately qualified physicians to practice in the communities served by the District.

Administration also requests the approval of the contract terms for the following:

- Professional Services Agreement between Salinas Valley Memorial Healthcare System and the two (2) physicians listed in the table above, contracted under a W-2 based professional services agreement
- Recruitment Agreement between Salinas Valley Memorial Healthcare System and the two (2) physicians listed in the table above with dollar amounts in the recruitment incentive column.

Overall favorable financial performance was driven by:

We successfully received payments on older aged accounts receivable totaling \$2.5 million. Had we not received this payment, our income from operations would have been \$2.0 million with an operating margin of 3.2%. Other key drivers included:

- Higher than budgeted patient volume for both in IP and OP, however, payor mix was unfavorable, but an improvement over last month.
- This is coupled with higher utilization of contract labor (\$2.4M) and overtime labor.
- Total gross revenues were over budget by \$29 million (13%):
 - ✓ Medicare and Medi-Cal were significantly over budget by \$24 million (35%) while Commercial was over budget by 11%.
 - ✓ Inpatient acuity/CMI remains lower than budget
 - ✓ Total admissions were 216 admits (26%) above budget, of those 185 (86%) were Medicare/Medi-Cal
- Total net patient revenues were \$8.6 million (16%) above budget driven by:
 - ✓ Increased patient volume
 - ✓ Additionally, OP infusion cases were at 994, 28% above budget
 - \checkmark IP and OP surgical cases were above budget by 12% and 14%, respectively
- Increased patient volume and staffing challenges continue to require higher than expected contract labor and overtime utilization.

• Overall Labor Productivity was favorable by 13% (134 FTEs ~ \$1.9 million) due to staffing efficiencies and unfilled budgeted positions. Non Operating Income was higher than budgeted due to better than expected gains in investment income.

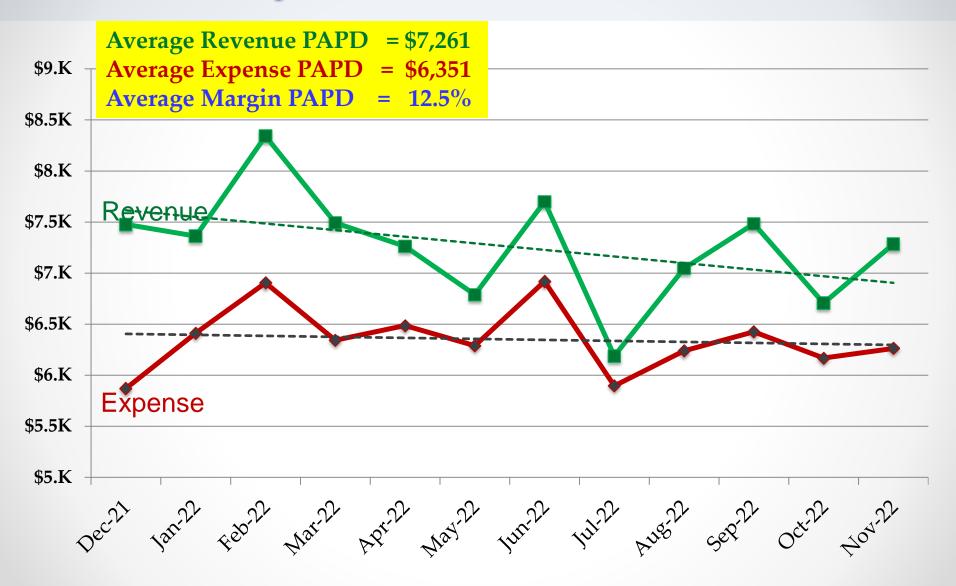

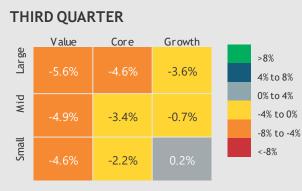
S&P 500 SECTORS: Q3 2022



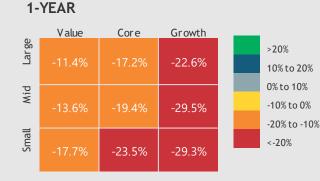

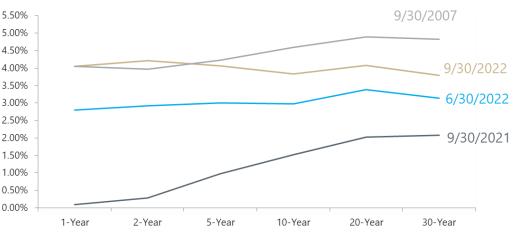

- Soaring inflation prompted the Fed to raise rates by 75 bps at three consecutive meetings each while they indicate more increases are ahead, propelling interest rates to their highest levels since 2008.
- Global bond markets were challenged by a dramatic change in tax policy in England that was immediately reversed & led to the ouster of their Prime Minister, the shortest Prime Minister appointment in England's history.

- Bonds are in the midst of one of their worst selloffs of the past century. Yields on two-year and ten-year treasuries saw their biggest yield gains since 1981
- A silver lining to rising rates is that after several years of extremely low bond yields, fixed income assets now offer relatively better income with more attractive valuations.

- The US Aggregate bond index is down 14%+ year-todate. A rare dynamic given bonds' typical role as a portfolio ballast when stocks plunge.
- If both global stocks and global bond returns are negative to end the year, it would only be the 3rd time since 1977 they have simultaneously lost value.

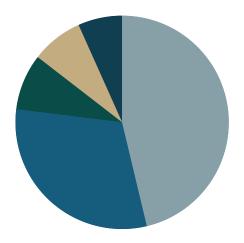

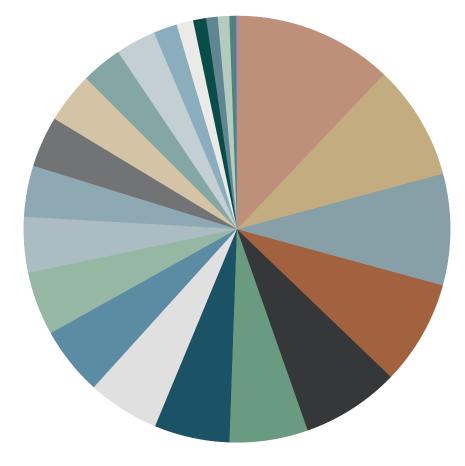

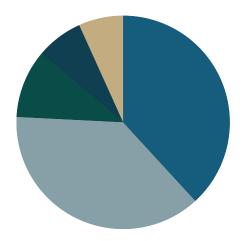

ALLOCATION OF PLAN ASSETS BY CATEGORY



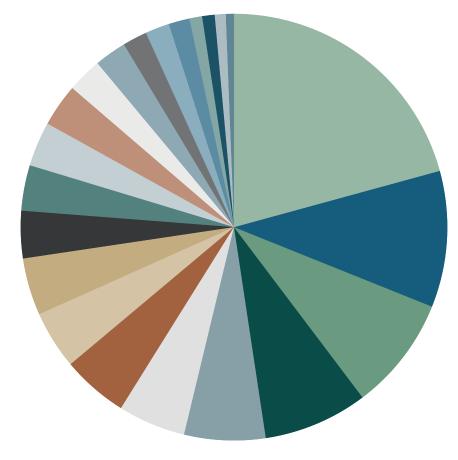

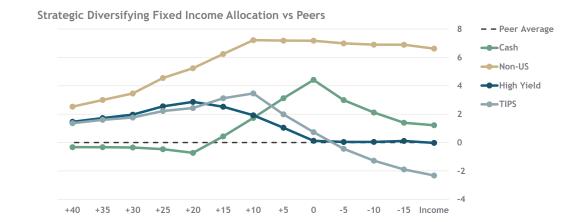
Glide Path Comparison

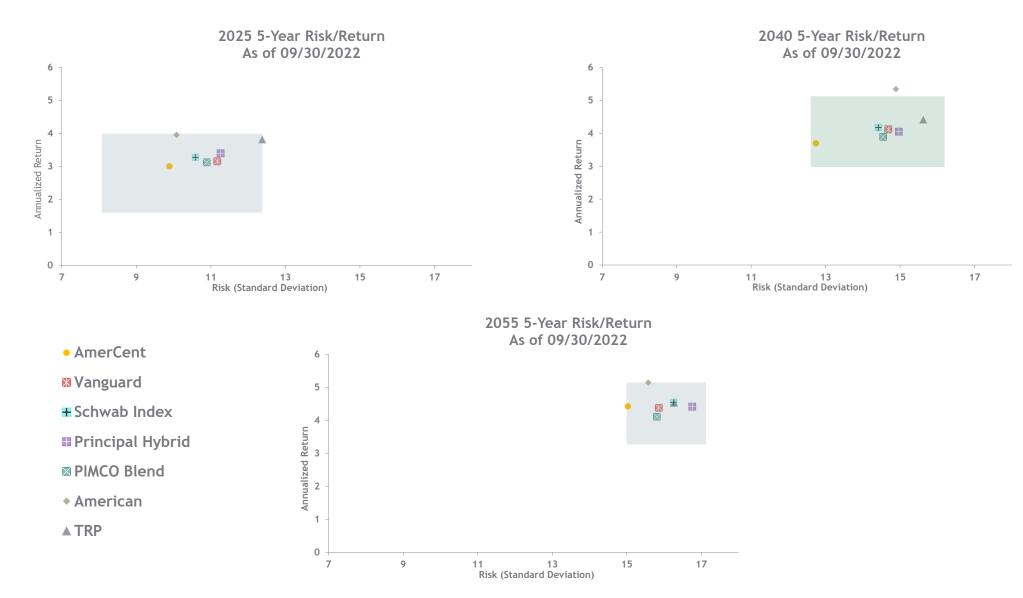


Rolling 5-Year Sharpe Ratio Rank vs 2055 Morningstar Category



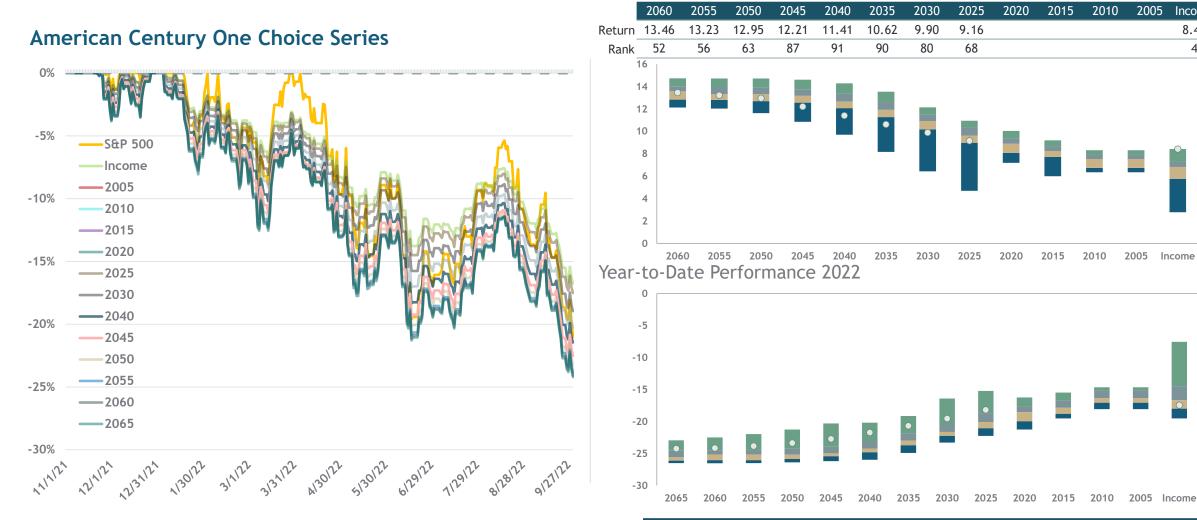

SECTION 5

Disclosures and Definitions

• 12(b)-1 fee: Mutual funds (which may be the underlying investment of a separate account) may charge this fee against the fund's assets to cover servicing costs incurred by the fund.

- Alpha: A measure of value added by a manager as compared to a passive portfolio with the same market sensitivity or beta. Alpha is a measure of return for residual, or nonmarket, risk and is used to measure a manager's contribution to performance due to security or sector selection.
- Annualized return: It is the geometric average return of an investment over a multiyear period. This shows what an investor would have earned on an annual basis over a certain period of time if the annual return was compounded.
- Batting average: A measure in percentage terms of how often the investment achieved a higher rate of return than its benchmark.
- Beta: Represents a fund's sensitivity to market movements. Beta is a measure of the linear relationship, over time, of the manager's returns and those of the benchmark. Beta is computed by regressing the manager's excess returns over the risk-free rate (cash proxy) against the excess returns of the benchmark over the risk free rate.
 - Beta = excess return covariance/excess return variance.
- Capture ratio: The portion of market (benchmark) performance that was captured by the manager under certain conditions. The capture ratio is equal to the ratio of the average annual return of the manager for a given period to the average benchmark return over the same period. Up market capture is the average return of the portfolio calculated using only periods where the market return is positive. An up market capture of greater than 100% is considered desirable. Down market capture is the average return of the portfolio calculated using only periods where the market return is negative. A down market capture of less than 100% is considered desirable.
- Correlation: A statistical measure of how two securities move in relation to each other. The correlation coefficient will vary from (-1.0) to 1.0. (-1.0) indicates perfect negative correlation, and 1.0 indicates perfect positive correlation.
- Expense ratio: The management fee charged by the fund's investment manager against the fund's assets for managing the portfolio as well as for such services as shareholder relations, investment-related administration (fund analysis, research, etc.), 12(b)-1 fees and "other expenses," if applicable. "Other expenses" include additional operating expenses charged by the fund's sponsor against the fund's assets, such as legal fees, compliance and auditing expenses, mailing and postage expenses, etc.
- Information ratio or excess information ratio corresponds to the more common industry definition of the term. It is the ratio of the excess annualized return over the tracking error (annualized standard deviation of excess return). Commonly stated as the measure of risk-adjusted excess return.
- Money market funds are not insured or guaranteed by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or any other government agency. Although the fund seeks to preserve the value of your investment at \$1.00 per share, it is possible to lose money by investing in the fund.

- R-squared: Measures the appropriateness of the benchmark by evaluating percentage variability in the manager's returns that can be explained by the benchmark's returns.
- Rank: Based on the return percentile of the fund. If the fund's three-year return is 15% and 30th percentile of the three-year return of the peer group is 15%, then the fund will be shown with a rank of 30.
- Risk: Measures the volatility of a stream of data compared to its average value. For investment performance, standard deviation measures dispersion from the mean over a given period of time.
- Sharpe ratio: Measures the quality of the returns for an investment on a risk-adjusted basis over a given period. It is defined as the excess returns of an investment divided by the standard deviation of returns. Excess returns are the returns of the investment minus the risk-free rate of return offered in the market, typically measured by short-term government instruments such as three-month treasury bills.
 - Sharpe ratio = (average excess returns x annualized factor)/annualized standard deviation.
 - Excess returns = investment return return of the three-month treasury bill.
- Sortino ratio: A modification of the Sharpe ratio that differentiates harmful volatility from general volatility by taking into account the standard deviation of negative asset returns, called downside deviation. The Sortino ratio subtracts the risk-free rate of return from the portfolio's return, and then divides that by the downside deviation. A large Sortino ratio indicates better risk-adjusted return and a historical tendency to have smaller losses when compared to similar peers.
- Standard deviation: Measures the degree of variation of returns around the mean (average) return. The higher the volatility of the investment returns, the higher the standard deviation.
- Tracking error: Measures the degree of variation of excess returns around the mean (average) return. The higher the volatility of a manager's excess returns, the higher the tracking error. Index funds will have very low tracking error, and actively managed products will have higher tracking error.

Morningstar ratings and averages

- The Morningstar rating for funds, commonly called the "star rating," assigns stars to funds based on their rankings relative to other funds within their categories. Funds are ranked within their categories according to their risk-adjusted return. A fund's risk-adjusted return is calculated by subtracting a risk penalty from such fund's total return, after accounting for all loads, sales charges and redemption fees. The risk penalty is determined by the amount of variation in the fund's monthly return during the rating period, with an emphasis on downward variation. The greater the variation, the larger the penalty. Funds are rated from one to five stars, with the best performers receiving five stars. Funds are ranked within their categories, and stars are assigned as follows: The 10% of funds in each category with the highest risk- adjusted return receive five stars; the next 22.5% receive four stars; the middle 35% receive three stars; the next 22.5% receive two stars; and the bottom 10% receive one star.
- Funds are rated for up to three periods the trailing three, five and 10 years and ratings are recalculated monthly. Funds with less than three years of performance history are not rated. A fund's overall star rating is a weighted average of the ratings for the three-, five-, and 10-year periods. For funds with only three years of performance history, their three-year star rating will be the same as their overall star rating. For funds with five-year records, their overall rating will be calculated based on a 60% weighting for the five-year rating and 40% for the three-year rating. For funds with more than a decade of performance, the overall rating will be weighted as 50% for the 10-year rating, 30% for the five-year rating, and 20% for the three-year rating. For multishare class funds, each share is rated separately.
- Morningstar averages are between 1 (low) and 5 (high). Averages reflect either 1) the average number of stars (both for a particular period as well as the overall rating) actually assigned by Morningstar to a fund family's individual funds or, if applicable, share classes or 2) in the case of the return rating or the risk rating, the average number of stars Morningstar would have assigned if such funds or, if applicable, share classes were rated solely in accordance with their return or risk. The higher the average for rating or return, the better. The lower the average for risk, the better.
- While Morningstar ratings and averages may serve as an initial evaluation of the funds or the fund company, they should not be the sole or primary basis for an investment decision. Individual fund analysis

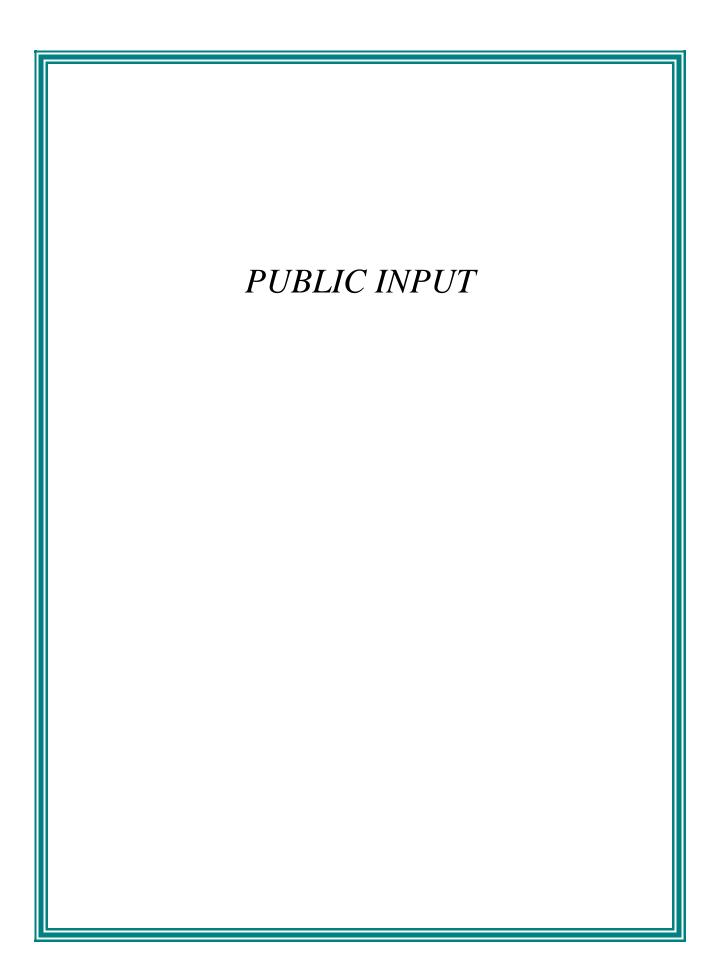
- Performance-to-date chart: The points for the fund and the benchmark are annualized returns for the to-date periods of one-year, three-year, five-year 10-year and the beginning return since inception. The colored bands are the distribution of the peer group. The top band is the fifth to 25th percentile, next the 25th to median, below that the median to 75th percentile, and the bottom band is the 75th to 95th percentile. For the corresponding table below the performance-to-date chart, the returns are calculated for the same periods as in the chart. For the peer group, it is showing the average return rather than the distribution.
- Calendar year performance chart: Displays the total return for the fund, universe peer group average and benchmark for each of the past five calendar years. The table below the calendar year performance chart lists the corresponding values.
- Three-year rolling performance ranking: Plots the annualized return ranking for each three-year window since the fund's inception. For example, if the fund has an inception date of June 1987, the first point in the chart is the ranking for the three-year annualized return from June 1987 to May 1990. The next point is ranking for the three-year annualized return for July 1987 to June 1990.
- Five-year rolling performance ranking: Plots the annualized return ranking for each five-year window since the fund's inception. For example, if the fund has an inception date of June 1987, the first point in the chart is the ranking for the five-year annualized return from June 1987 to May 1992. The next point is ranking for the five-year annualized return from June 1987 to May 1992. The next point is ranking for the five-year annualized return for July 1987 to June 1992.
- Three-year rolling risk ranking: Plots the annualized standard deviation ranking for each three-year window since the fund's inception. For example, if the fund has an inception date of June 1987, the first point in the chart is the ranking for the three-year annualized standard deviation from June 1987 to May 1990. The next point is ranking for the three-year annualized standard deviation for July 1987 to June 1990.
- Style map: Displays the average style from a six-month window, every month for the past six months, with the largest shapes representing the most recent time periods. This means that each manager will have only one point, the average style from a six-month window beginning six months ago. For example, the linear mapping for a U.S. equity style map would be as follows:
 - X coordinates = (large growth + small growth) (large value + small value).
 - Y coordinates = (large growth + large value) (small growth + small value).
 - A large growth index fund would have coordinates of (1,1) with X = (1 + 0) (0 + 0) = 1 and Y = (1 + 0) (0 + 0) = 1 The 1s correspond with a 100% weighting in that asset class. Therefore, a 50-50 small blend would have coordinates of (0,-1) and be represented as X = (0 + 0.5) (0 + 0.5) 0 and Y = (0 + 0) (0.5 + 0.5) = -1
 - The same logic can be applied to alternative style maps (i.e., fixed income); the only differences are the different asset classes.

- 36-month rolling down market capture ratio chart: Plots the down market capture ratio for each three-year window since the fund's inception. These capture ratios are calculated with 36-month rolling windows, meaning the first point will be the capture ratio for the 36 months beginning from inception. The capture ratio calculates the portion of market (benchmark) performance that was captured by the manager under certain conditions. The capture ratio is equal to the ratio of the average annual return of the manager for a given period to the average benchmark return over the same period. Down market capture is the average return of the portfolio calculated using only periods where the market return is negative. A down market capture of less than 100% is considered desirable.
- Performance versus risk graph: Represents the annualized return (Y-axis) and the annualized standard deviation (X-axis) for the last 60 months. The small squares on the chart represent the members of the peer group.
