Mobile Clinic | Clínica Móvil

SERVICES OFFERED

Healthcare services provided through the Salinas Valley Health Mobile Clinic during its weekly community visits include:

- Diabetes care
- Flu vaccines (seasonal)
- Primary care
- Rapid results testing COVID, flu, strep, glucose, pregnancy and more
- Resources to manage chronic medical conditions
- Simple urgent care
- Sports physicals
- UTI/STD screenings
- Vaccines for Children (VFC) Eligible children 18 years and younger who have Medi-Cal, are uninsured, or are American Indian or Alaska Native can receive free immunizations
- Wellness screenings

All services provided by the Salinas Valley Health Mobile Clinic are currently free of charge. The mobile clinic is dedicated to improving the health of our community by increasing access to care for those in medically underserved areas, providing preventive and primary care where it is needed. Our mobile clinic is a state-of-the-art 40-foot vehicle featuring two exam rooms, Wi-Fi and laboratory capabilities, and educational functionality. It is staffed with a Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant, Medical Assistant and a Community Health Advocate.

Nuestra clínica móvil es un vehículo de última generación de 40 pies que cuenta con dos salas de examen para pacientes. El personal incluye una enfermera especializada o un asistente médico, un defensor de la salud comunitaria y un coordinador de apoyo comunitario.

Todos los servicios proporcionados por la Clínica Móvil de Salinas Valley Health son actualmente gratuitos. La Clínica Móvil se dedica a mejorar la salud de nuestra comunidad aumentando el acceso a la atención para quienes viven en áreas médicamente desatendidas, brindando atención primaria y preventiva donde sea necesaria.
