DAYS OF DISCOVERY





After a 3-year hiatus due to COVID-19, this summer kids with special needs were able to get back into the water for the Monterey Bay Aquarium's annual Days of Discovery, funded through a partnership with the Salinas Valley Health Foundation and our Children's Miracle Network Hospitals Program.

This unique program gets kids between the ages of 8 and 14 with varying special needs into the water to experience surface scuba diving, many for the first time. Regardless of the child's needs, the experience is adapted to their specific abilities and comfort levels.

During the free program, each child tries on a dry suit, mask and regulator, based on their own comfort level. Then with the support of two or more skilled divers, they enter the water to surface dive in the Aquarium's Great Tide Pool.

Divers guide the child, pointing out interesting ocean animals, ensuring a memorable experience. As needed, adaptive gear is provided so every child can view the amazing world found under the surface of the ocean comfortably and safely. Over three days this past summer, nearly 100 children participated in what the divers call "the best day of the year."









Impact at a Glance FY23 Year End

937 Individuals totaling \$108,103 in assistance


Type of Assistance




Patient Age






Impact at a Glance FY23 Year End

Hear from ER Physician Dr. Erica Locke, and local families who have lost loved ones to overdose. NARCAN will be available for free distribution from 6:00pm - 8:00pm or while supplies last, and a candlelight vigil will be held at 8:00pm, recognizing the 813 overdoses treated and the 87 lives lost to overdose in Monterey County in 2022.
