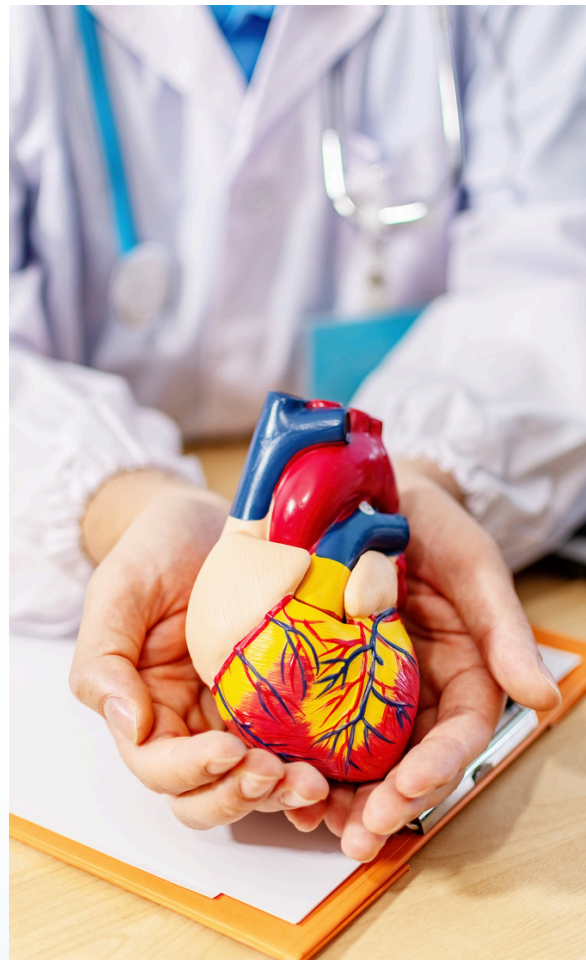

In FY24 the Salinas Valley Health cardiac catheterization lab began conducting Percutaneous Transluminal Arterial Bypass (PTAB) using the DETOUR System. This minimally invasive intervention treats peripheral arterial disease (PAD) using stents to restore blood flow to the leg as an alternative to an open surgical bypass procedure. Salinas Valley Health was one of only two hospitals in the country selected to participate in the nationwide launch of this intervention, and successfully treated their first two patients in July of 2024.
